How do you qualify to become a member of the GEMS club?

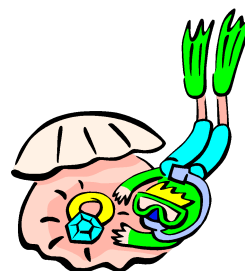
- **Have an *interest* in science and/or math.** It's not necessary to be an "A" student in these classes. You do not need to be interested in all the GEMS areas.
